Effective August 1, 2013, in an effort to maintain a family-friendly environment and provide for the safety and security of staff, inmates, and visitors; all visitors will be required to wear appropriate clothing to conduct business (e.g. inmate visitation, bonding) on jail properties.

Visitors will not be allowed to enter if they are dressed in any clothing that distracts, disturbs, and/or offends staff, inmates, or other visitors. Proper undergarments are required and must not be visible.

Visitors **WILL NOT** be permitted to enter jail properties to conduct business if they are attired in any prohibited clothing items listed below:

- Shorts, skirts, and dresses that are more than two (2) inches above the knee.
- Jeans/pants with excessive holes, rips, and/or tears.
- Leggings, spandex, or tights worn as pants.
- Excessively baggy bottoms/pants or tops/shirts.
- Low cut tops that expose cleavage or chest.
- Crop tops that expose the mid-drift area, belly button and/or buttock area.
- Sleeveless tops, tank tops, and tops with spaghetti straps.
- Clothing that is transparent, mesh, and/or fish net.
- Clothing that displays and/or gives reference to profane language, drugs, sex, or violence.
- Pajamas/Sleepwear
- Flip-flops and shoes that have no strap securing them to foot

Additionally, the items listed below are prohibited:

- Cigarette lighters and/or tobacco products
- Electronic devices (e.g. cameras, cell phones, laptops, tablets, video/tape recorders)
- Personal food and drinks
- Purses, pouches, laptop bags, backpacks, etc.
- Sharp objects (knives, fingernail clippers, collapsible scissors, etc.), weapons, and/or ammunition

Note: Possession of or attempted distribution of any contraband (e.g. alcohol, drugs, cigarettes or tobacco products, weapons, cell phones, indecent photos or magazines) will result in the immediate prosecution of all parties involved.
